Receipts, incorrect/incomplete entry fines and Under Paid Entries (where applicable) are payable/collectable at the time of collecting your exhibit numbers, numbers will not be handed out until all monies due have been paid

Timetable please ensure you familiarise yourself with the timetable as classes will not always run in numerical order. Classes will not be held up nor will they commence ahead of scheduled time. By the same token we do not expect any horse to be in two places at the same time, but we cannot be held responsible for Handler/Rider clashes.

Marshalling is 15 minutes prior to each class, it is your responsibility to make sure that you are in time for your Marshalling call.

Exhibitors Please Note: No exhibitors will be permitted to enter the ring once the Marshall has closed the ring, (handed the ring card over to the steward and shut the arena gate.)

No pedestrian access is available via the tunnel through the arena, all spectators, handlers and grooms are to enter the spectator area at the entry points on either side of the arena. This rule will be strictly adhered to.

Exhibitors Meeting: An exhibitors briefing will be held on Wednesday 10th at 5pm in the Marshalling area. Finals night briefing is scheduled for Saturday 13th at 10am, please assemble in the seating area near the canteen.

Stabling: Entry is not possible before 2pm Monday 8th March, anyone wishing to arrive on Monday please contact Greg Liddle giving at least 45 minutes notice on: 0419 407 154. All arrivals after Monday to contact our Stable Monitor, Martin Gregson who will be in the vicinity of the stable area. Should you be unable to locate Martin upon arrival or if you are arriving late at night, you can contact him on mobile no 0420 901 948 or 0411 545 310.

We request that exhibitors make an effort to arrive before 9pm or after 6.00 am.

It is imperative that you bring your own water and feed buckets and ensure that your horse has adequate amounts of water when left in a stable.

Stables do not have any bedding provided unless you ordered some at the time of entry. Should you require extra bedding a limited amount of shavings will be available for \$12.00 per bag (incl. GST). Any extra bedding required is to be paid for at the office and receipt to be presented to the stable monitor for delivery to your stable.

Stable occupation time is from 5pm to 5pm, therefore a Thursday stable starts at 5pm Wednesday evening and MUST be vacated by 5pm Thursday evening as someone else may have paid to use that stable from 5pm Thursday onwards. Our Stable Monitor and Horsley Park officials will be doing regular checks on the stables.

No wheelbarrows or forks to clean out stables are provided so you must bring your own. We also advise you to bring a broom.

Do NOT alter or damage the stables, do NOT put nails or staples in the walls of them and please leave them in the same condition in which they were found. Should any stable be damaged in anyway, you will be responsible for any repair costs incurred.

Please do not tie horses to the mesh of the stables or surrounding railings on the grounds, there is a tie up ring located inside each stable. There will be continual patrols by the security officers of the grounds and anybody found to be in breach of regulations may find themselves evicted from the grounds.

Stable Bonds When vacating your stable, you must completely clean out all waste & bedding. After your stable has been inspected and signed off by the Stable Monitor, you will be given a Stable Bond slip which will allow you to reclaim your Stable Bond from the Show Office. If the Show Office is closed, you can post your Stable Bond slip to the Association at PO Box 125, Richmond NSW 2753 after the show and your Bond will be destroyed or returned if requested in due course. The area outside and around your stables must also be left in a clean and tidy condition.

Camping & Cabins Our Stable Monitor and SIEC officials will be doing regular checks on the camping sites and cabins ensuring only those that have paid for and been allocated sites or cabins are using them. Anyone found to be using a site or cabin that has not been paid for or allocated to them will be evicted from the Centre. Please ensure that you leave cabins clean and tidy ie. any mud off floor, etc. or a \$10.00 cleaning fee may be incurred.

Presentation Night: Stabling for Saturday evening can be booked with the Secretary/Office at the show on Thursday or Friday ONLY, not Saturday morning. All stable bookings made at the show will need to be paid for at the office and proof of payment produced to the Stable Monitor before your stable will be unlocked. Any horse found in a stable that has not been paid for on Saturday will be removed and the stable will be locked until proof of payment has been produced.

Presentation Night Tickets: Presentation Night Tickets are available for purchase at the office during the show or at the entry points of the arena Saturday evening. Ticket prices are as follows: Adults - \$16.50, Children (5-12yrs) - \$11.00 inclusive of GST. If you have ordered and paid for tickets on your entry forms they will be enclosed with your neck numbers and catalogue at the office.

Dinner Tables: Tickets for all dinner tables purchased are available for pickup at the office during the show. If you need make alternative arrangements for pickup, please contact the show Secretary

Show Rules The 2010 East Coast Arabian Championships is conducted under the rules of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited together with the rules and definitions printed in the schedule. Copies are available from the Show Secretary.

Special Sash Classes Only 3 horses per rider combinations will be permitted to enter the 3 & 4 Young Saddle Horse Classes and the East Coast Cups. No saddle horse will be permitted to enter the ring at any time without a suitably attired/capable rider.

Any form of cruelty, whip abuse or horses presented with whip marks will find owners/handlers excused from their respective classes and an appropriate penalty will be determined at a hearing by the Committee.

Washbays All manure your horse deposits on the washbays must be collected immediately and put in the waste bins provided.

Day Parking you will be instructed where to park by an official on the day. Every effort has been made to secure parking for your convenience. We ask that those of you working out of your trucks and floats do not take up more than your fair share of the parking.

General Rules Enforced by SIEC

Horses are NOT to be worked, lunged or walked in any areas other than the round yards or nominated warm-up arenas. This is to be STRICTLY adhered to. There are many covenants on the land and riding is strictly prohibited anywhere other than stipulated.

You are responsible for your horse and its actions. The show committee and members of the NSW Arabian Horse Association Inc. accept no responsibility for any accident, injury or damage to any spectator, competitor, goods, property, pedestrian or vehicle. There will be constant traffic within the confines of Horsley Park so please exercise due care.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times.

Do NOT cook or smoke within the stable compound. This is a safety related issue and strict penalties apply. Fines of up to \$150 on the spot. As this venue has strict rules about smoking, the only designated area is located out the front of the stable complex.

As this is considered a special event in accordance with the RTA & policing bodies, please be advised that there will be police patrols in the local vicinity. You are responsible for your actions and we advise you to exercise due care if having a drink and driving home.
