### 2011 National Breeders Sweepstakes Stallion Service Auction General Rules as at June 2011

1. Stallion services will be donated by the Stallion Owner free of charge to the NSW AHA Inc. in accordance with the Stallion's breeding contract.
2. The NSW AHA Inc. will hold a real time online and live auction of the services with all bidders required to be registered prior to bidding.
3. Bidding will commence on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2011 provided all of the required information on the Stallion has been provided to the Association, and will conclude at varying times on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2011.
4. Bids will start at a minimum of 50% of the Stallion's normal service fee.
5. The Stallion Owner will be entitled to enter one progeny of the Stallion in the 2013 National Breeders Sweepstakes class at their own expense.
6. To ensure entry of the progeny to the 2013 National Breeders Sweepstakes class, the Stallion Owner must submit a completed and signed Mare Nomination form to the Association prior to 30 June 2012.
7. The Purchaser of the service will be entitled to enter the resulting progeny from the purchase of the service in the 2013 National Breeders Sweepstakes class at their own expense.
8. To ensure entry of the progeny to the 2013 National Breeders Sweepstakes class, the Purchaser of the service must submit a completed and signed Mare Nomination form to the Association prior to 30 June 2012.
9. The Purchaser of the service must pay the full amount of the service fee to the Association within seven (7) days of receiving notification from the Association that they were the successful bidder at the auction.
10. The Stallion Owner will provide the Purchaser of the service with all necessary signed paperwork to enable the Purchaser to register the foal resulting from the service with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia and any other registry the resulting foal may be eligible to enter.
11. 50% of the auction proceeds will be set aside in a Futurity Fund as prizemoney to be divided between the purebred and derivative sections, dependant on the resulting foal, at the 2013 National Breeders Sweepstakes.
12. The Purchaser of the service must use the service in the 2011/2012 breeding season. Should a non pregnancy or unfulfilled Live Foal Guarantee occur, the Purchaser of the service can re breed the mare to the Stallion for progeny to compete in the 2014 National Breeders Sweepstakes class, however 25% of the cost of the service will be included in the 2013 National Breeders Sweepstakes prizemoney, and a further 25% of the cost of the service will go to the 2014 National Breeders Sweepstakes prizemoney.
13. Prizemoney breakdown in each class will be: Champion - 45%, Reserve - 25%, Top 5 - 10%, Top 5 - 10% & Top 5 - 10%.
14. Where a derivative foal results from someone purchasing a purebred stallion service, the service funds made will go into the derivative pool of prizemoney.
15. Any disputes relating to these Rules must be heard in NSW, regardless of where the Stallion Owner or the Purchaser of the service reside.
