# **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. To compete at this show in any event, you must not have trained or shown a horse for any remuneration within the last 3 years including remuneration such as sponsorship, gifts, accommodation, travel cost or entry fees.
- 2. To compete in Ring 3 you must hold a current AHSA Amateur Card. You will be required to show your Amateur Card when purchasing tickets.
- 3. To compete in the Beginner ring, competitors must not have won a champion or reserve at any graded Arabian show, gymkhana, agricultural or hack show. Beginners are not eligible to compete in Smartest on Parade, or to show in the breed or open rings, just as open ring competitors are not permitted to compete in the Beginner ring. Horses competing in the Beginner ring must be wearing an EFA approved snaffle bit only, no double bridles permitted.
- 4. Ribbons will be to 6<sup>th</sup> place (where applicable) and the Judge's decision is final.
- 5. Smartest on Parade is open to all open ring competitors and is to be judged in Ring 1 at 8.30am. This is a best presented horse class, (including handler), ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place with 1<sup>st</sup> place receiving a Special Sash.
- 6. Supreme Led Exhibit of show is to be judged at lunchtime in Ring 1 all halter champions are eligible to compete (Beginner Ring not included). Supreme Ridden Exhibit and Supreme Rider of Show to be judged in Ring 1 at the completion of each ring all saddle champions and rider champions are eligible to compete in their respective Supreme (Beginner Ring not included).
- 7. A Show Hunter must be sound with well-balanced, ground covering paces, be of quality type, substance and bone. Horses do not have to jump, however a forward canter should be included. Browbands are to be unadorned. Hacking canes or riding crops (with or without flappers) may be carried, maximum length must not exceed 75cm (30 inches). Dummy spurs may be worn but dressage whips are not permitted.
- 8. Competitors must choose to enter either the Open classes or Show Hunter classes, and cannot compete in both.
- 9. Where sponsorship prizes/trophies are applicable, failure to collect these awards on the day of the show may result in those awards being forfeited.
- 10. Definitions:-

Novice – Horse/rider not having won a 1<sup>st</sup> place in a similar event at a hack or agricultural show. Intermediate – Horse/rider not having won a Championship or Reserve Championship in a similar event at a hack or agricultural show.

Youth - Rider/handler under 18 years of age.

- 11. Age of all riders/handlers to be as at the day of the show.
- 12. Age of all horses or ponies to be calculated as from 1st August.
- 13. All protests must be lodged in writing with the show secretary at the office within 30 minutes of the event and accompanied by \$50.00 cash.
- 14. The NSW Arabian Horse Association Inc. accepts no responsibility for any accident, injury or damage to any spectators, competitors, goods, property, pedestrians or vehicles. You are fully responsible for your horse and it's actions.
- 15. No stallions or colts may be handled, ridden or driven by any person under the age of 18 years.
- 16. Stallions are only permitted to compete in classes where indicated.
- 17. The show committee shall have the power without assigning any reason to issue a warning and/or excuse a competitor from the ring due to excessive use of whips, spurs, bits or due to any horse not being under proper control.
- 18. Any competitor whose conduct is considered to be ill mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike will be issued a warning and may be asked to leave the ring.
- 19. Condition of entry is that a "Registered Participant Application" form is completed and a \$10.00 levy (or participation fee) is paid prior to purchasing tickets if you are NOT a current financial member of the NSW Arabian Horse Association Inc, the Arabian Horse Society of Australia or a recognised affiliate of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. An "AHSA Condition of Entry Declaration Form" must be completed by current financial members of the NSW Arabian Horse Association Horse Association Inc, the Arabian Horse Society of Australia or a recognised affiliate of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. An "AHSA Condition of Entry Declaration Form" must be completed by current financial members of the NSW Arabian Horse Association Inc, the Arabian Horse Society of Australia or a recognised affiliate of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia prior to purchasing tickets however no insurance levy is payable. Wristbands must be worn by all persons to enter any ring.
- 20. This show will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the current Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited Rule Book, a copy of which is available at the show office or at <u>www.ahsa.asn.au</u>.

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the proprietors of the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasee") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.
